Aims

The Rudbaxton Parish Education Fund aims to advance the education of children and young people under the age of 25 who live in the Parish of Rudbaxton, in Pembrokeshire.

Who can apply?

- Individuals under the age of 25 who are resident in the Parish of Rudbaxton
- Community/voluntary groups and local charities either based in Rudbaxton or whose work directly benefits individuals under the age of 25 living in Rudbaxton. Schools and PTAs may apply but only for projects which fall outside of statutory provision

Grants available

- Individuals can apply for grants of up to £1000 per annum
- Organisations can apply for grants of up to £2000 per annum

In exceptional circumstances the trustees may consider awarding larger grants where a strong case for support can be made.

What can grants be used for?

Individuals

- Grants to support the costs of students in further/higher education
- Grants to school pupils for materials, equipment and activities/trips

Examples could include: university bursaries, equipment/materials for higher education courses, travel costs to college, course fees (where other support is not available e.g. student loan)

Organisations

- towards running costs of a project
- minor capital works
- to purchase equipment and materials
- to contribute to the costs of educational materials, trips and outings

Examples could include: a community-based youth initiative, a community education programme, holiday clubs, educational outings. We welcome applications for new initiatives and we're happy to discuss any proposals with potential applicants.

How to apply

Any individual applicants under the age of 16 will need to have the application form completed by a parent or guardian. Applications will be considered twice a year. The closing dates are **28th February** and **31st August** each year.
